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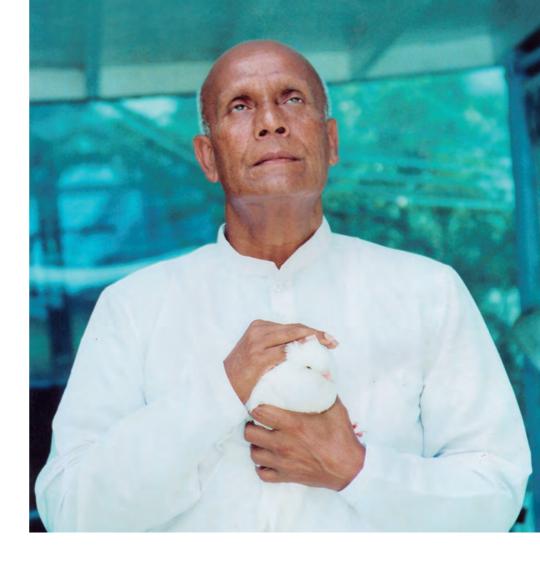


Preface

Sri Chinmoy — a philosopher, poet, visionary, mystic and yogi — doubtlessly ranks among the great sages in the history of humanity. Born in India in 1931, he was raised in a spiritual community. In 1964, following an inner command, he moved to New York. There, until his passing in 2007, he led a very active, committed and creative life, producing a multitude of books, songs, paintings and drawings. Sri Chinmoy also initiated many international sports events, peace activities and humanitarian programmes.

Promoting the spiritual path of the heart, Sri Chinmoy established flourishing meditation centres on all continents. As a mystic, he spent countless hours in meditation, where he experienced union with the Source, with the Supreme Being. The source of all his achievements is God Himself, he liked to point out, while considering himself a mere instrument or channel. And this is what makes his books so unique and incredibly fascinating!

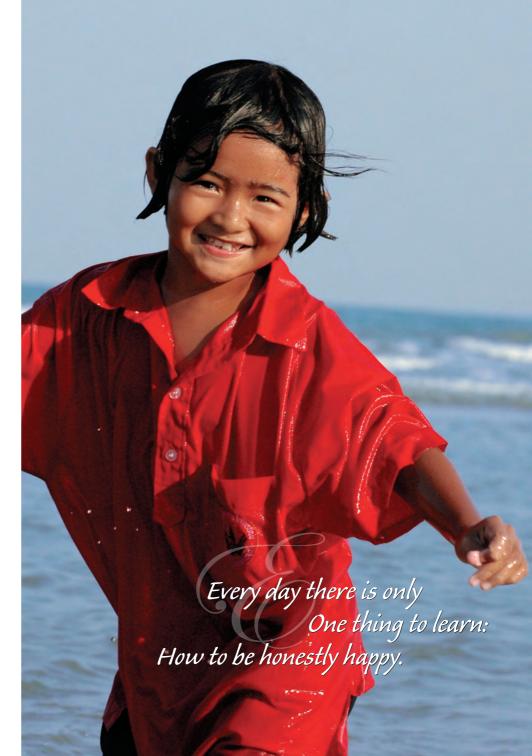

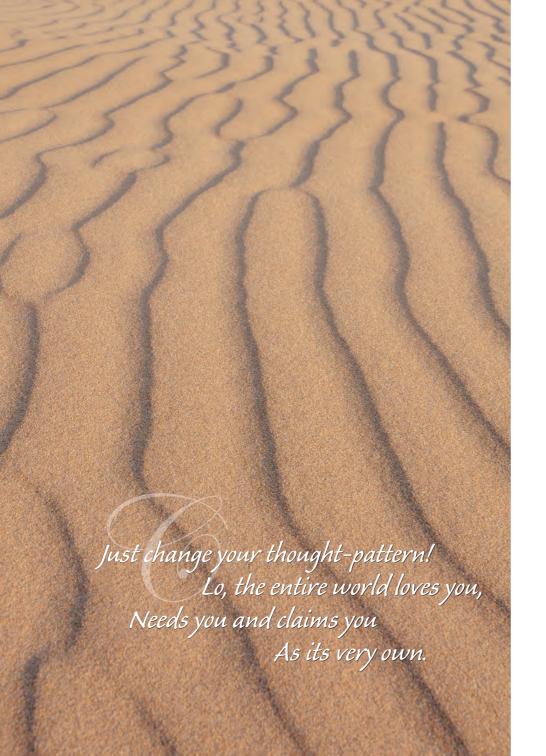
Do not waste

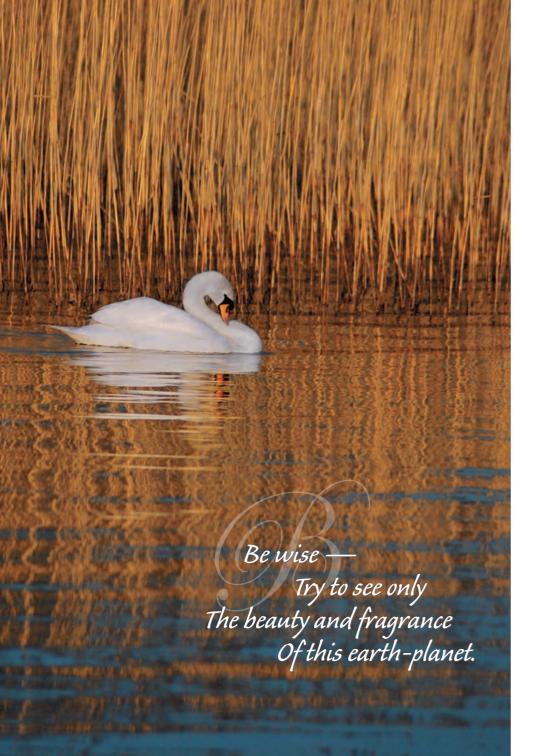
Alas, my poor desire-life

Then change yourself first.

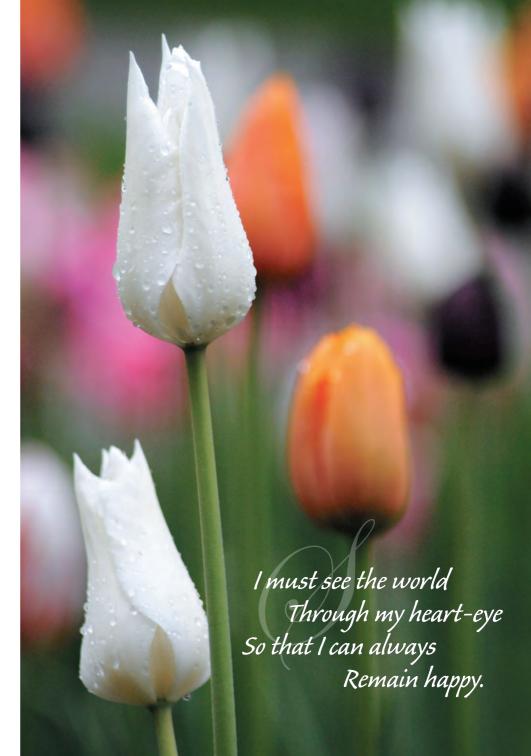
Do you want to change yourself?

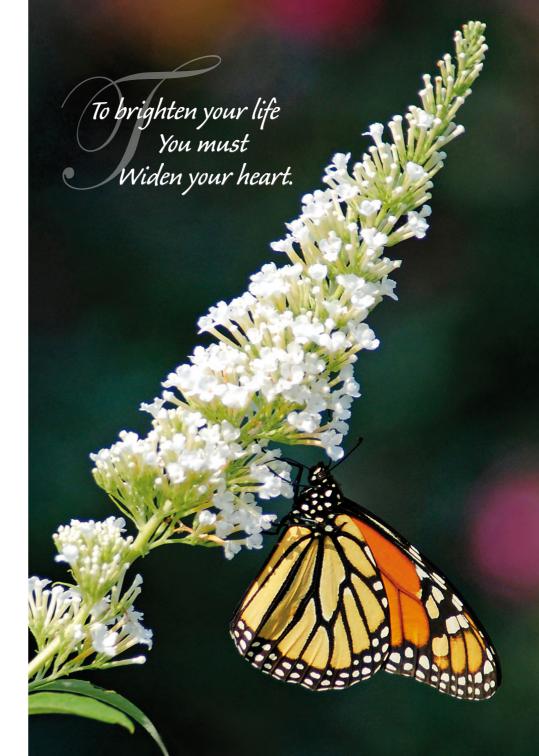
To conquer the ego Is to gain Boundless freedom.

With no expectation

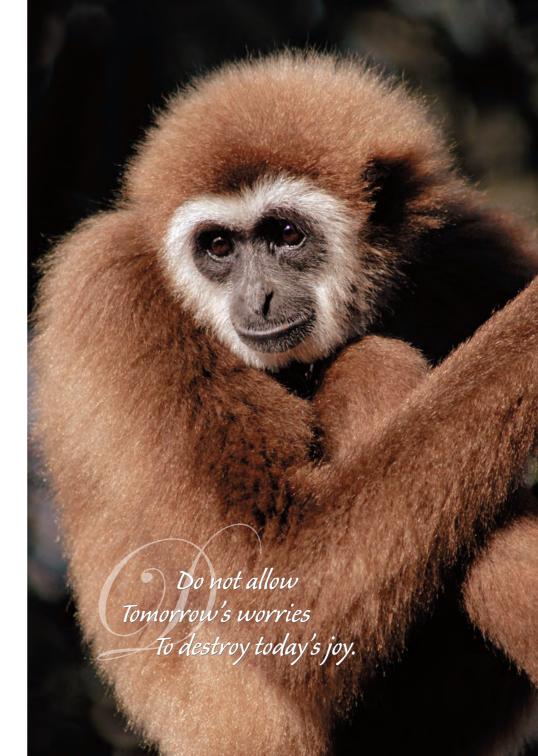
Of return.

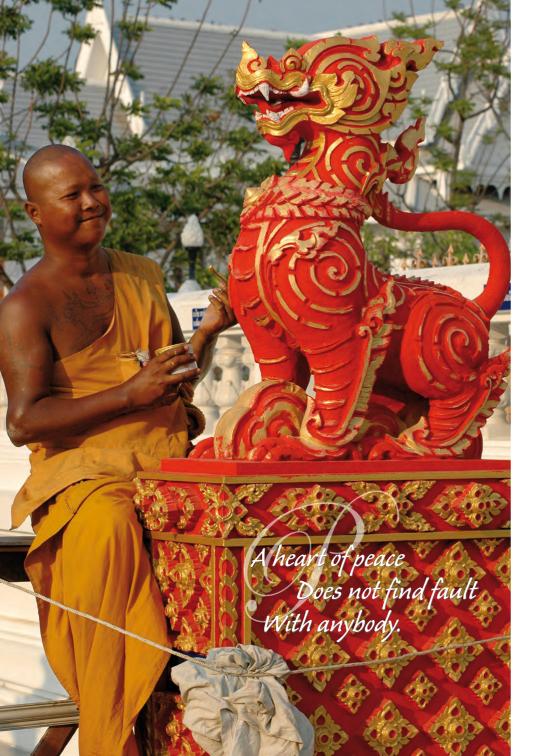

What we need is only

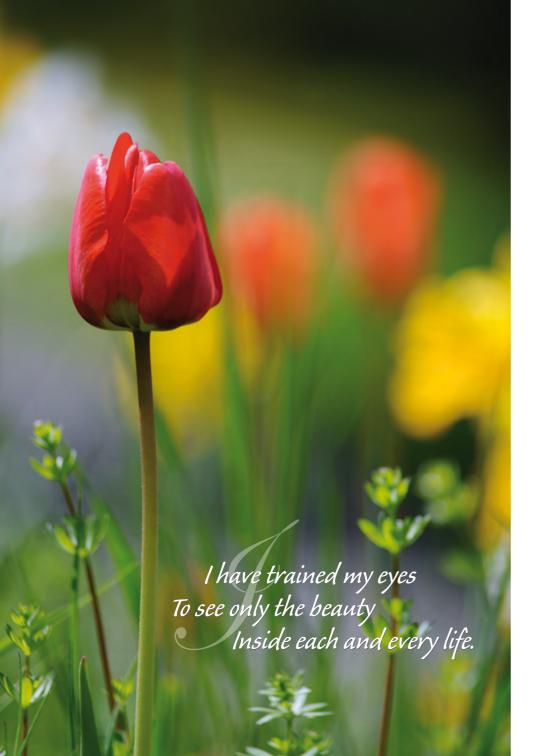
A little more love

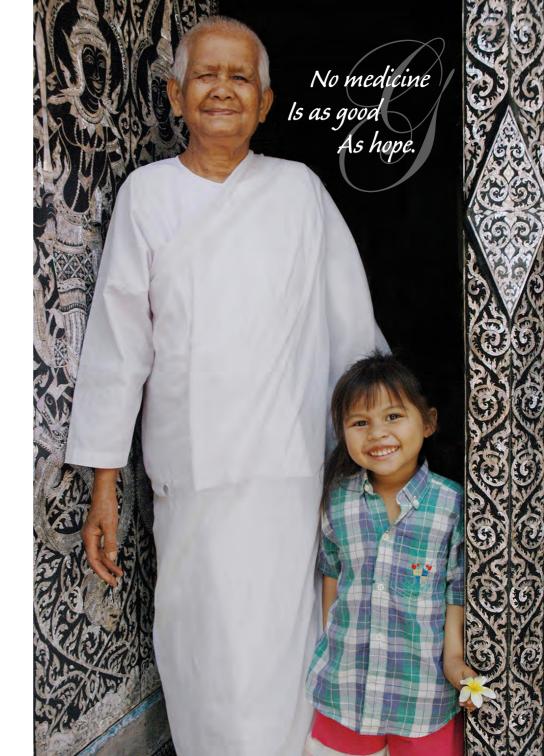
When we have an inner smile,

A very, very long time.

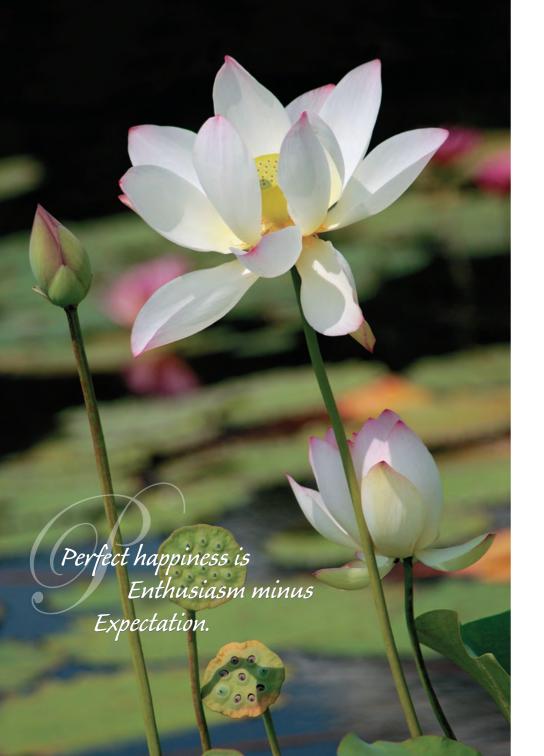

I love my enemies for two reasons: They inspire me to recognise my weakness. They also inspire me to perfect my imperfect nature.





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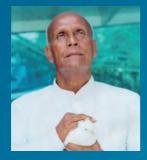
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The Eternal Journey
